Items to Not Bring & Prohibited Items

Mounted TVs*	Illegal Substances or Paraphernalia*	Pets/Animals*	Any device that creates an open flame or has an open heating element*
Candles*	Weapons*	AC Units*	Any chemical or substance that has a potential for combustion that is not cooking related (fireworks, fuel, etc.)*
Mini Fridges*	Water Devices >10 gal.*	Any device that is not UL approved*	Non-fused extension cords or multi-plug outlets*
LED strip lights*	Items that are already included in the apartment (ex. microwave)		

** = prohibited items (policy violation)*
